Satisfaction Survey

Once again this March, students in Grade 10 and Grade 12 along with their parents will be asked to complete a Ministry of Education survey. Students will be completing the survey during the school day. During Parent/Teacher Interviews on Thursday, March 4th, the downstairs computer lab (Room 108), will be set up for any parents of Grade 10/12 students wishing to complete the Survey.

“Online Parent Teacher Appointment Schedule”

(Parent/Teacher Interviews – March 4th) – CHSS will be piloting an “Online Parent Teacher Appointment Schedule” program. The system allows the parents to go online and select times (in the schedule) to meet with your child’s teachers.

- Teachers are able to prepare in advance for parents that will be meeting with them during the parent-teacher appointments.
- Parents will be able to visually manage their appointments making the scheduling process much easier and accurate.
- Parents can login to the site, setup their accounts and make their appointments beginning on March 1st.
- Appointments made entirely on-line.
- Sign-up for appointments can still be done at the school on March 4th.

Details will be posted on the school web site and emailed to parents/guardians later this month.
